F. General Discussion

There was a general discussion by Committee members regarding the importance of census data.

G. Subcommittee Reports

Business-Industry (BI) Subcommittee:

Chairman Luis Diaz stated that the Subcommittee continues to seek involvement from the business community in the 2010 Census. He mentioned he heard a Spanish DJ conducting a radio show on the census.

Education-Governmental (EG) Subcommittee:

Steve Noto announced that the City of Lake Mary has notified city residents of the census via water bill inserts, magazines, events, bulletin boards, and farmer's market. Tony Matthews read into the record information from Marjorie Murray from Seminole County Public Schools regarding census awareness and the "Meet Me at the Mailbox outreach (**see attachments provided by Ms. Murray**).

Faith-Based/Ethnic-Cultural Based (FBEC) Subcommittee:

Angie Romagosa, Chair of the FBEC Subcommittee, reported that census activities have included speaking before various groups, notices to homeowners associations, churches, County service organizations, and homeless families.

Karen van Caulil stated that she has been distributing census information.

County Staff Report:

Tony Matthews, Seminole County Growth Management Department, noted that it is likely too late to notify businesses regarding their participation in the census prior to April 1. Mr. Matthews mentioned that real time census participation rates are now

available on line. Mr. Matthews mention that there is more to come for the Committee's involvement in the 2010 Census.

Davia Moss, Seminole County Leisure Services Department, stated that the County sent out an email to 16,000 + residents and that, to date, 4,500 residents had opened the email (**see attached campaign report data**). She stated that she is working on the next press release.

H. Census Awareness Activities:

Tom Boyko suggested that the County issue a challenge to city commissions to get the word out about the census

Karen van Caulil suggested that any press release include directions regarding where to obtain a census form if not received via the mail and ways to encourage residents to mail back their census form (**see attached be counted notice**).

Tony Matthews passed around a photo of the census billboard on SR 436 and proposed posters for LYNX bus stops (**see attached photo and posters**).

- I. Chairman Langlotz directed Tony Matthews to send out the list of focus areas to the Committee.

J. Other Business

John Horvath stated that Chairman Langlotz (absent from this meeting) can set the April meeting. Mr. Horvath also stated that he will be attending the Casselberry City Commission meeting on March 22 as part of census awareness efforts.



Hi Tony,

I have a scheduling conflict and will not be able to attend the Complete Count Census meeting this evening.

The following are some updates from the school system initiatives:

- 1) The call-out system broadcast a census message to 43,402 phone numbers on Wednesday, March 17. The message was in English, however, the TeleParent system which broadcasts a message to English Language Learners will be broadcasting the message in Spanish to families whose primary language is Spanish.
- 2) The yellow Census information card is going home in the backpacks today.
- 3) The school marquees will post the "2010 Census form - Don't Delay - Mail Today - Be Counted message beginning next Monday". Some marquees may not be able to accommodate the entire message so it may be a version of that message.
- 4) The "Meet Me at the Mailbox" campaign began today in the Housing Authority complexes. See the attachment in Publisher and Word. I delivered over 500 books and educational games to The Harbor at Castle Brewer Court. The staff advertised in the surrounding neighborhoods and churches adjacent to the Housing Authority. Over the past two days when I was delivering the books and games, I heard parents passing by in their cars, rolling down the windows, and saying to the teacher, "I received my census form today and I am going to meet you at the mailbox." We are hopeful that this will help with the return rate in that area.

I apologize for missing the meeting.




If You Got a Form, You'll be Counted in The Right Location

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I need to make sure that we all understand that there is a difference between the address on the mailings you receive from the Census Bureau and the physical location of your house.

Some of the addresses on census forms list a city name that is not yours (some even arrive without a city name). Don't worry.

IF YOU RECEIVED A CENSUS FORM AT YOUR HOME, YOUR RETURN WILL BE COUNTED IN THE JURISDICTION WHERE YOUR HOME IS PHYSICALLY LOCATED.

The 2010 Census mail-out is the largest single delivery ever undertaken by the United States – over 120 million forms were mailed this week. To streamline delivery in a mailing this large, addresses in a particular ZIP code sometimes were all labeled using a single city name that is valid for the ZIP code, even though some people in that area usually receive mail addressed to a different city name. The Postal Service does not have a problem with this because for many addresses there are multiple city names that are perfectly acceptable for accurate delivery.

If you got a form at your address, you're fine. Fill it out, mail it back, just as it is. (Please don't cross out the bar code or the address). We will place your return with the right area. If you got the form, we have coded your house to the right geography.





F. General Discussion

Correction to minutes: Tom Boyko and Lauren Schulenberg were present at the January 21, 2010 meeting.

Chairman Langlotz introduced Desta Horner of CMF Media. Ms. Horner gave a brief description of CMF Media Company. Ms. Horner later interviewed Dick Langlotz, Angie Romagosa, Marjorie Murray, and Tony Matthews for an upcoming web program on the 2010 Census and the Complete Count Committee. (Note: The web address for this program is <http://cmfmedia.org/2010/03/2010-census-the-complete-count/>).

G. Subcommittee Reports

Education-Governmental (EG) Subcommittee:

Benjamin Paris, Chair of the EG Subcommittee, stated that the City of Longwood is sending out the Census Informational Flyer (rack card) in utility bills and that the Subcommittee has distributed many other rack cards. Mr. Paris noted that he attended the U.S. Bureau's Office Open House in Lake Mary. He noted that a Census article is forthcoming in the Altamonte Springs City Magazine.

Marjorie Murray stated that Census awareness has been included in the Seminole County Schools Calendar and newsletters. Students are using Facebook to spread the word about the Census. Census information was provided via "Light up Lyman". The School system is using public service announcements to promote the Census and has distributed approximately 120,000 rack cards. The School system is using a call out phone message and marquee signs. Free books are available for those who attend "March to the Mailbox".

Kristi Aday has arranged for the marquee at the Sanford Baseball Field on Mellonville Avenue to display a message regarding the Census.

Adam Reichbach stated that there will be rack cards at the Jazz Festival in the City of Casselberry in late February.

Lauren Schulenberg stated that the Uptown Altamonte event will not allow for distribution of Census flyers.

Laura Feldman said that she has heard that the University of Central Florida and the University of South Florida are engaging in a challenge regarding which school can reach the most students about the Census.

Faith-Based/Ethnic-Cultural Based (FBEC) Subcommittee:

Angie Romagosa, Chair of the FBEC Subcommittee, reported that the FBEC Subcommittee had reached out to 129 churches and distributed approximately 2,000 rack cards in food bags. She also stated that the FBEC Subcommittee is reaching out to the homeless population. The FBEC Subcommittee has spoken to civic groups and plans to continue speaking to groups in the future. Ms. Romagosa also stated that she is using the Sharing Center's newsletter for Census awareness. The FBEC Subcommittee will also be reaching out to the "Meals on Wheels" organization. Ms. Romagosa will also contact the United Way to determine how the FBEC Subcommittee can assist with Census awareness.

H. Census Bureau Report:

Shirley Rivers, Partnership Specialist with the U.S. Census Bureau, stated that what the School Board is doing has been submitted to the Census Office in Atlanta as an excellent example of Census awareness. She stated that she is securing Questionnaire Assistance Centers and Be Counted Sites and that she needs 44 locations. She stated that she attended the Census Road Tour at Daytona Beach. She stated that the "Advanced Letter" regarding the Census will arrive soon and that the "March to the Mailbox" efforts will begin soon. Ms. Rivers said that Census Tract 20500 had only a three (3) percent return rate in 2000. She would like to see

a Questionnaire Assistance Center in the Dreamwold area of Sanford. Ms. Rivers reminder the Committee that there are a number of hard-to-count areas that need to be contacted about the Census. Ms. Rivers stated that undercounted residents tend to move around and thus add to being hard to count. She noted that trust is important to ensure that forms are returned. Ms. Rivers mentioned that locations with Hispanic areas are needed to reach this population. According to Ms. Rivers, United Way may already be a partner with the Census Bureau. Ms. Rivers also noted that some populations of the Lake Monroe area were not counted in 2000 due to a zip code issue.

I. County Staff Report:

Tony Matthews, Seminole County Growth Management Department, reported that he attended the U.S. Census Open House on February 5, 2010. He mentioned that he would be attending the campuses of Seminole State College for Census awareness in March. Mr. Matthews stressed the need to compile a list of activities to focus on for Census awareness. Mr. Matthews reminded the Committee to forward any email lists to him for the planned email send out by the County. He also mentioned that John Horvath, Vice Chairman of the Complete Count Committee, was attending a meeting of the Lake Mary City Commission (February 18) regarding the Census.

Davia Moss, Seminole County Leisure Services Department, updated the Committee on media outreach. She mentioned, of note, about the planned email send out by the County to approximately 20,000 residents.

J. Census Awareness Ideas and Activities

The Committee reviewed a list of Census awareness activities/events provided by Tony Matthews. Benjamin Paris moved (seconded by Lauren Schulenberg) to select five (5) areas for focus on with Census awareness. These are:






F. Subcommittee Reports

Business-Industry (BI) Subcommittee:

Luis Diaz delivered a box of the informational flyer (rack card) for distribution to the Committee, around 20,000 copies. Mr. Diaz talked about methods for encouraging business awareness of the Census. He also noted that Walgreen's may be contacted by a member of the subcommittee regarding Census awareness. Progress Energy cannot mail flyers due postage weight issue. There was a brief discussion about a student poster design contest in Lake County.

Education-Governmental (EG) Subcommittee:

Helen Ehrgott stated that she is available to attend events if needed.

Benjamin Paris stated that all proclamations are now accomplished.

Marjorie Murray stated that the School Board will make use of school marquee signs to promote the Census. Ms. Murray also stated that the School Board has an in-house sub group relating to Census awareness. Students will develop public service announcement for school events and will perform phone notification message to student families. The School Board may have up to three (3) locations for Be Counted sites.

Laura Feldman stated that the City of Oviedo is creating a "place setting" display (where people eat, sleep, live) in the Oviedo City Hall.

Karen van Caull said her efforts are focused on populations that may not respond to the Census.

She is looking at placing the Census informational flyer in food baskets via the food pantries. Her office is training workers to inform people of the Census. She informed the Committee that Ms. Romagosa has sent a letter to churches and the Census and Census jobs. Ms van Caullil has also shown a Census video to agencies with which she is associated.

Meals on Wheels and property management companies are being notified of the Census.

Chairman Langlotz stated that most of the Census flyers should go to the Faith-Based/Ethnic-Cultural Based Subcommittee for distribution.

County Staff Report:

Davia Moss informed the Committee that the latest press release went out today. She stated that media alerts would go out soon regarding the Census proclamations approved by the various parties to the Committee. She also stated that there are now 70 posters installed along County trail sites.

Tony Matthews stated that he had contacted local chambers of commerce to request a link to the County's Census website. He stated that the League of Women Voters has responded positively. He stated that he will attend an "energy fair" at the Seminole Towne Center on January 23 and will include a Census display. Mr. Matthews further stated that he has spoken with Seminole State College regarding linking with the County's Census website. Mr. Matthews informed the Committee that the County is still reaching out to billboard companies for a donation for space. He recognized Helen Ehrgott from the Supervisor of Elections, as a new member, replacing Alex Setzer from the Elections Office.

Census Bureau Report:

Jose Martinez, U.S. Census Bureau, noted that the Census "road tour" is now underway, and will make stops at the Super Bowl in Miami and the Daytona 500 in Daytona Beach. He stated that Questionnaire Assistance Centers and Be Counted sites will be in operation from mid March to mid April. Questionnaire Assistance Centers are needed in hard to count areas. He informed the Committee that the new partnership specialist for Seminole County is Shirley Rivers. Mr. Martinez said that he will provide information relating to hard to count areas.

G. Census Awareness Ideas and Activities – Choice of Activities

Chairman Langlotz commended the Committee for their work. He also thanked the County for posters along County trails. He asked the Committee for any other ideas regarding Census awareness.

Benjamin Paris suggested the idea of contacting convenience stores to place Census information flyers at gas pumps.

Jose Martinez stated that there are new toolboxes on the Census website and that the web should be checked from time-to-time for updates. He suggested that flea markets are a location for Census flyers.

Marjorie Murray asked if there are new posters.

Laura Feldman suggested that each city conduct a Census event and that the Committee consider placing Census signs along roadways, with the proper permit.

Karen van Caullil said she will continue to distribute posters.

Tony Matthews mentioned that LYNX will have a bus (maybe more than one) that will cycle throughout the LYNX service areas with a Census logo.

Davia Moss mentioned the air photo raid event occurring on January 23 as an opportunity for Census rack cards.

Tony Matthews said that the County can use its mass email list to contact residents and that the Committee could add its lists to this email.

Marjorie Murray said the School Board will be using the slogan: "Don't Delay, Mail Today, Be Counted" for the School Board's awareness activities. (Note: the Committee voted to use this slogan).

Tony Matthews recommended that the Committee choose what activities and events they want to pursue as Census Day draws closer. He suggested that the Committee create a list and choose those ideas that will focus on the hard to count population, while not neglecting the ideas the Committee and subcommittees are already pursuing or planning. Mr. Matthews will prepare a list for discussion at the Committee meeting in February.







He has contacted Seminole County Libraries about the possibility of hosting a "box" for drop-off of completed Census questionnaires. He noted that churches are well suited as QACs along with auto tag offices, DMV offices, and Centra Care facilities.

Chairman Langlotz stated that he will attend the Board of County Commissioners meeting on January 12, 2010, and will meet with Board members before that date to discuss the possibility of County owned facilities as BC sites and QAC sites.

Marjorie Murray has created a form for use in acquiring locations for BC sites and QAC sites and will send to Tony Matthews (**see attached forms**).

Chairman Langlotz noted that the Committee should act on these good promotional ideas.

E. Approval of October 19, 2009 Minutes

The October 19, 2009, minutes were approved without any changes from the draft submitted to the Committee on November 18, 2009 (see attached).

Chairman Langlotz encouraged the Committee to "think out of the box" for ideas to use in 2010 to promote the Census. He recommended that the Committee use the yellow colored flyer distributed by County staff (see attached) as a way of promoting the Census. Mr. Langlotz requested County staff to look into the idea of procurement as a way of funding copying and mailing of the flyer.

F. Subcommittee Reports

Business-Industry (BI) Subcommittee:

Chairman Diaz stated that the BI had met on two (2) occasions. He stated that the BI Subcommittee discussed the purpose and mission of the Subcommittee and had engaged in brainstorming to promote the Census such as via reaching out to professional organizations, local malls, and chambers of commerce.

Education-Governmental (EG) Subcommittee:

Marjorie Murray stated that the EG Subcommittee had met on three (3) occasions. She noted that there is on-going coordination among the County's municipalities to adopt Census proclamations. She distributed a calendar from the School Board containing a notice about the Census. She stated that Census curriculum is underway in the school system. She is preparing to send out the yellow flyer to school employees. Benjamin Paris, Chair of the EG Subcommittee was absent from the meeting.

Faith-Based/Ethnic Cultural-Based (FBCB) Subcommittee:

Chair Angie Romagosa stated the FBCB Subcommittee had held two (2) meetings. She noted that the Subcommittee had created a list of contacts to use in reaching out to promote the Census including a list of email contacts and church contacts.

Chairman Langlotz suggested that the Subcommittee contact the Catholic Dioceses to get endorsements regarding the Census.

Mr. Jose Martinez, Partnership Specialist with the U.S. Census Bureau informed the Committee that he has already administered Census training to some local pastors

and priests and reminded the Committee to focus on Black and Spanish churches. Mr. Martinez explained the Questionnaire Assistance Center concept encouraged by the Bureau. Editor's Note: End of Subcommittee Reports.

G. County Staff Report:

Tony Matthews, Principal Planner, Seminole County Planning Division, informed the Committee that the County had issued an initial press release regarding the Census. Mr. Matthews also showed the Committee the County's Census website. Editor's Note: End of County Staff Report.

H. Census Awareness Ideas and Activities

Marjorie Murray made mention of the group in the Midway area of Sanford that is promoting the Census and she also mentioned the upcoming video sequence to occur at the old school house in downtown Sanford regarding the Census. Vice-Chairman, John Horvath, mentioned that the Catholic Dioceses has already released a news article regarding the importance of the Census. There was general discussion regarding faith-based groups.

The Committee approved the idea of seeking funding from the U.S. Government to assist with the Committee's efforts; idea introduced by Chairman Langlotz.

Davia Moss, Program Manager, with the Seminole County Leisure Services Department, stated that the County's trail kiosks are available for displaying Census posters.

The idea of County staff wearing a button that mentioned the Census was raised.

Marjorie Murray requested Tony Matthews to send an email to the Committee regarding how to spend PSP funding.

Chairman Langlotz directed the Committee to come up with a slogan for the Census to discuss at the next Committee meeting. He also appointed the Business-Industry Subcommittee to come up with ideas to distribute the yellow flyer and for

the Education-Governmental Subcommittee to come up with ideas for distributing Census posters. Mr. Langlotz also encouraged the Committee to move forward toward action steps on their respective ideas for Census awareness.

Tom Boyko reminded the Committee not to forget billboards as a way of promoting the Census.

I. Partnership Support Program

Jose Martinez spoke about the Partnership Support Program and encouraged the Subcommittees to apply soon due to limited funding available. Mr. Martinez suggested promotional ideas and the idea of adopting a Census logo for Seminole County.

J. Future Meeting Dates

The Committee determined that future meetings will be from 6:00-7:30 p.m., and that the next Committee meeting will be at the School Board Offices on Lake Mary Boulevard. Future Committee meeting dates were set as: December 17, 2009, January 21, 2010, February 18, 2010, and March 18, 2010. These meeting will occur at the Seminole County Central Branch Library in Casselberry.

K. Other Business

John Horvath mentioned the need to plan an event to promote the Census. Jose Martinez announced that the Census Bureau is currently recruiting jobs and he briefly explained the process. He also explained that residents are counted where that live or sleep most of the time. He mentioned that Census questionnaires will be arriving in March 2010.






It's Important! Your participation is needed. Returning your form can bring additional funding to Seminole County. Funding for roadway improvements, schools, health care, and many other services is beneficial to our community's quality of life. Census data also determines the number of seats in the U.S. House of Representatives and used for redrawing state and local legislative districts.
