**THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE
REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA ON THE
27th DAY OF JANUARY, A.D., 2004.**

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER has served Seminole County and its citizens with the highest level of integrity, dedication and expertise for seventeen years; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER began her career in Seminole County in January 1986 as a member of the Women, Infant and Children program of the Seminole County Health Department and served there faithfully for five years; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER began her career with Seminole County Government in January 1991 in what is now the Division of Community Assistance of the Department of Community Services; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER has shown a genuine compassionate spirit by serving in a leadership role with numerous community organizations including the *Goldsboro Front Porch Initiative*, *Seminole Volunteer Enterprises*, *Seminole HOPE*, *The Seminole County Police Athletic League*, the *New Life Word Center Prison Ministry* and the *Lockhart Community Organization*; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER has served her fellow employees by volunteering for the Seminole County Sick Leave Bank Committee; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER has further demonstrated a genuine commitment to serving others by participating in three separate "Women Build" projects through Habitat For Humanity; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER provided assistance and encouragement to the families devastated by the tornados that struck in February 1998; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER was recognized for her dedication and commitment by receiving the 1999 Seminole County Community Service Award; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER has demonstrated a willingness to accept every role and responsibility given her with patience and perseverance as she worked with families in the midst of very difficult and traumatic experiences; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER is recognized and appreciated by her co-workers for her professionalism, even temperament, and the respect she shows to others; and

WHEREAS, ALGERINE MILLER will officially be retiring effective January 31, 2004.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County, Florida that this resolution be spread upon the official Minutes of the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for the County of Seminole, and that this Resolution be presented to ALGERINE MILLER in recognition and appreciation of her seventeen years of service to the citizens of Seminole County.
