MOTION/RECOMMENDATION:

Approval and authorization for the Chairman to execute the attached Budget Amendment to enter the Vitamin Settlement Award for \$50,000 into the Seminole County Sheriff's Office budget.

BACKGROUND:

Several states filed a multi-state anti-trust price-fixing lawsuit against several manufactures of vitamins and vitamin products. Awards from this settlement were made to various non-profit and political subdivisions based on proposals by these agencies. The Seminole County Sheriff's Office was awarded \$50,000 to be split \$20,000 for child nutrition activities held by the Police Athletic League and \$30,000 to a local non-profit (Pathways to Care) for feeding of medically underserved. No match is required and no new positions are associated with this grant.
