**MOTION/RECOMMENDATION:**

Adopt Resolution renaming a portion of Artesia Avenue/Street to Panther Street.

(District 2 – Commissioner Randy Morris)

**BACKGROUND:**

In November of 2003, Seminole County Public Safety requested the County and the City of Oviedo rename a segment of Artesia Avenue/Street to eliminate confusion regarding E9-1-1 emergency response. This segment of Artesia is not continuous and the associated plats were recorded with a mix of the designations, Street and Avenue. The segment of Artesia Avenue/Street to be renamed begins at Lake Charm Drive and travels easterly to Stone Street.

County Addressing staff and staff from the City of Oviedo contacted the property owners to notify them of the proposed street name change and requested they participate in the street renaming process.

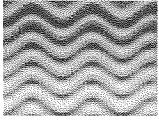
Twenty three street name suggestions were submitted by property owners. Of the names submitted, six met the street naming criteria: Boystown, Hepler, Sedona, Wild Boar, Panther and Saint Louis. On a prepaid post card the property owners were requested to cast their vote for one of the six approved street names. Eighteen postcards were sent, eleven postcards were returned. The voting outcome was as follows: Four for Panther, three for Sedona, two for Wild Boar and two for Boystown.

To date no one has contacted our office in opposition to the proposed street name change.

Staff recommendation is to rename this segment of Artesia Avenue/Street to Panther Street.

Dear Property Owner:

In 1986, the E9-1-1 Emergency Response System was implemented in Seminole County for this system to operate efficiently it is imperative street name duplication is avoided.

In a public safety effort, our office received a request to rename a segment of Artesia Avenue also know as East Artesia Ave; located in the recorded Plat of Black Hammock, Plat Book 1 Page 31, Addition to Black Hammock Plat Book 3 Page 20 and Black Hammock Plat Book 1 Page 108. The segment of Artesia Avenue we propose to rename is located between Lake Charm Drive and Stone Street. As an affected property owner, we request your participation in the street renaming process. Enclosed is a prepaid postcard. Please provide up to three street name suggestions; for the names to be considered they cannot duplicate an existing street name in Seminole County.

To ensure you street name suggestions are considered, please send your postcard by May 12, 2004; the week of May 17, 2004, we will compile a list of approved names; the week of May 17, 2004 we will notify you of the approved proposed street names and ask you to vote for the name of your choice on a prepaid postcard. Once a name is chosen, we will present the item to the Board of County Commissioners at their regularly scheduled meeting for approval. When the street name is legally changed, we will make a request to Traffic Engineering to install street signs then the affected property owners (presently addressed to Artesia Avenue) will be readdressed to the new street.

Dear Property Owner:

In a letter dated March 26, 2004 you were notified of a joint public safety effort between Seminole County and the City of Oviedo regarding a proposal to rename a segment Artesia Street/Avenue; additionally, we requested your participation in the process by submitting street name suggestions. As stated, the segment of Artesia we propose to rename affects property owners in Seminole County and the City of Oviedo.

From the County and City property owners we received 23 street name suggestions, of the names submitted six meet the street naming criteria: Boystown, Hepler, Sedona, Wild Boar, Panther and Saint Louis. In a letter dated August 3, 2004 you were asked to participate by casting your voting for one of the six street names on a pre paid postcard. Eighteen postcards were sent, eleven postcards were returned, the voting outcome: four for Panther, three for Sedona, two for Wild Boar and two for Boystown.

To coincide with the City of Oviedo, the proposal to rename the segment of Artesia Avenue/Street is scheduled for action by the Board of County Commissioners on February 22, 2005. If the Board renames the street segment from Artesia Street/Avenue to Panther Street, new street signs will be installed and affected properties will receive a change of address.

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT THEIR REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF, FEBRUARY 22, 2005

WHEREAS, under the authority contained in Section 336.05 (1) and 336.05 (2), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners may name and rename streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received to rename a segment of Artesia Avenue/Street, from Lake Charm Drive to Stone Street, located in Township 21 Range 31 and Section 3 Lot 12, Township 21 Range 31 Section 11 Lot 3A, Black Hammock PB 3 PG 20 Lots 1 and 2A, Black Hammock PB 1 PB 108 Lots 241 and 337, Black Hammock PB 1 PG 31 lots, 77A, 77, 144A, 144C, 144, 149A, 149, 147B, 147A, 148A, 148B, 148, 237 and 240, Black Hammock PB 2 PG 111 Lot E and D, Meadow Crest PB 47 PGs 19 & 20 lots 1, 2 and 3, Burns Addition to Black Hammock PB 66 PG 32 lots 1 and 2 Public Records of Seminole County, Florida.

WHEREAS, renaming this street will help to eliminate confusion, facilitate improved emergency access and ability of the public to locate streets and roads within Seminole County, and,

WHEREAS, this change is consistent with overall County plans for street naming, addressing and the 911 system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that effective, February 22, 2005, a segment of Artesia Avenue/Street be changed as follows:

ORDINANCE NO. 1292

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE NAME OF ARTESIA AVENUE AS DESIGNATED ON THE PLAT OF GARDEN GROVE UNIT ONE, PLAT BOOK 18, PAGES 97 & 98; AND MEADOWCREST, PLAT BOOK 47, PAGES 19 & 20, AND LAKE CHARM COUNTRY ESTATES, PLAT BOOK 64, PAGES 81 & 82 TO PANTHER STREET; PROVIDING FOR SEPARABILITY, CONFLICTS, AND EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, The City Council of the City of Oviedo, Florida recognized the possible hazard to life or property due to confusion resulting in duplications of street names.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Oviedo, Florida, deems it in the best interest of the City and public safety to change the street name of that portion of Artesia Avenue, between Lake Charm Drive and Stone Street, to Panther Street.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ENACTED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF OVIEDO, FLORIDA:

Section 1: That the street designated as Artesia Avenue with ROW shown on the plat Garden Grove Unit One, Plat Book 18, Page 97 & 98 and Meadowcrest, Plat Book 47, Pages 19 & 20, and Lake Charm Country Estates, Plat Book 64, Pages 81 & 82 and as depicted in Exhibit "A" is hereby changed to Panther Street.

Section 2: The provisions of this ordinance are declared to be separable and if any section, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance shall for any reason be held invalid or unconstitutional, such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining sections, sentences, phrases, or clauses of this ordinance, but they shall remain in effect, it being the legislative intent that this ordinance shall stand notwithstanding the invalidity of any part.

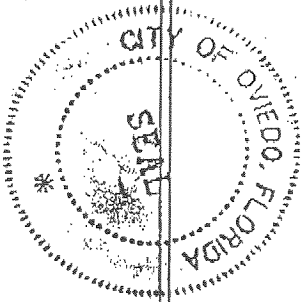
Section 3: All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith be and the same are hereby repealed.
