BACKGROUND:

As part of the 2nd Generation Sales Tax Program, the intersection of State Road 436 and Red Bug Lake Road was identified for a major transportation improvement. The proposed project is currently in the Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study phase. The PD&E study has identified five proposed alternatives, which will be presented and discussed at the April 26, 2005 Public Hearing. Details on these alternatives as well as an alternative recommendation will be included in the agenda package for the public hearing.

Currently, the project is in the PD&E phase. This PD&E study is required to comply with all Federal and State laws, rules, and regulations, and to ensure eligibility for future Federal funding. The study will prepare a Preliminary Engineering Report and a Programmatic Categorical Exclusion to obtain Federal Highway Administration (FHWA) Location and Design Concept Acceptance (LDCA).

The PD&E study has identified five proposed alternatives, which will be presented and discussed at the April 26, 2005 Public Hearing. Details on these alternatives will be included in the agenda package for the public hearing.
