RESOLUTION

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED
AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY
COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA
ON THE 10th DAY OF MAY, A.D., 2005.

WHEREAS, Public Works services provided in our community are an integral part of our citizens' everyday lives; and,

WHEREAS, the support of an informed and understanding citizenry is vital to the successful operation of infrastructure and programs provided by the Departments of Public Works and Environmental Services; and,

WHEREAS, the health, safety, and quality of life of this community greatly depend on these facilities and services; and,

WHEREAS, the quality and effectiveness of these facilities, as well as their planning, design, construction, and maintenance are vitally dependent upon the efforts and skill of Public Works and Environmental Services staff; and,

WHEREAS, the efficiency of the dedicated members of these departments is materially influenced by the public's perception and understanding of the importance of the work they perform; and,

WHEREAS, the American Public Works Association annually sponsors National Public Works Week and this year's theme is "**Public Works is Everywhere You Look**", to reflect the all-encompassing nature of public works;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County, Florida, does hereby proclaim May 15-21, 2005, as **NATIONAL PUBLIC WORKS WEEK** in Seminole County, Florida, and calls upon citizens and civic organizations to acquaint themselves with the challenges involved in providing public works services and to recognize the contributions staff make every day to our health, safety, and quality of life.
