Dear Mr. Grace

It has come to my attention that two pieces of equipment from within the County Fleet will soon be scheduled for surveying; specifically, a **Mack Semi-Tractor** utilized by the Fire Department at Station 42 in Geneva to pull a water tanker and a **Transport Trailer** (BC #11360) utilized by the Roads Department. The Sheriff's Office is interested in re-utilizing this equipment prior to the equipment being surveyed.

The tractor-trailer combination would be used to transport our rescue vehicle, helicopters and other heavy support equipment. This equipment would improve the Sheriff's Office state of readiness to respond to critical incidents, not only within Seminole County but also in Central Florida, as a partner in the State's Regional Anti-Terrorism Task Force. The Roads Department has assisted us on numerous occasions in the past with transporting equipment to such events.

The re-utilization of the tractor-trailer combination by the Sheriff's Office would ensure this equipment would also remain available to the County's Public Safety and Roads Divisions in time of extraordinary need, such as natural disasters.

Your consideration in this matter is greatly appreciated.
