BACKGROUND:

On February 10, 2004, the Board requested a staff briefing regarding the County's annexation review process, including a recap of affected areas and projected impacts.

On May 25, 2004, staff will present a brief Powerpoint presentation focusing on findings to date by the interdepartmental working group which is studying this issue. Information to be overviewed includes the acreage and location of recent annexations; land valuation; existing intergovernmental notification process; and planned future research and analysis. Impending renewal provisions of the current joint planning agreement between Seminole County and City of Oviedo will also be discussed.
