12' lanes and micro-surfacing the entire roadway from Longwood Markham Road to Markham Woods Road.

This project was publicly advertised and the County received two responses. The Review Committee consisting of Co-Co Wu, Antoine Khoury, Brett Blackadar, and Steve Krug, evaluated the submittals. Consideration was given to bid price, qualifications and experience.

The Review Committee recommends award of the contract to the lowest priced, responsive, responsible bidder, Florida Highway Products, Inc. of Bartow, in the amount of \$269,996.00. The completion time for this project is ninety (90) calendar days from issuance of the Notice to Proceed by the County.
