**THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT  
THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE  
COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON THE 8th DAY  
OF JUNE, AD., 2004.**
