ON THE 8th DAY OF JUNE, A.D., 2004**

**WHEREAS**, Amateur Radio Operators are dedicated to serve the citizens of Seminole County by providing emergency communications when all normal means of communications have failed; and

**WHEREAS**, Amateur Radio Operators donate their services free of charge in the interest of the citizens of Seminole County as well as the world; and

**WHEREAS**, locally, The Lake Monroe Amateur Radio Society remains ready to assist the general population of Seminole County in the event of an emergency that would disrupt normal communications by phone or electronic mail; and

**WHEREAS**, these Amateur Radio Operators are on alert for any emergency world-wide and practice their communication skills during the American Radio Relay League's Field Day exercise; and

**WHEREAS**, this year's Amateur Radio Field Day will take place on June 26, 2004, at the Central Winds Park in Winter Springs, Florida; and

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** by the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners that the week of June 20 - 27, 2004, be declared as
