

11. Approve Amendment #1 for PS-586-01/BJC – Solid Waste Management Engineering Services, with SCS Engineers, Tampa.

PS-586-01/BJC provides three consultants for full-service professional engineering services to the Solid Waste Management Division. The Consultants provide on-going professional engineering services on an as-when and needed basis to the active solid waste landfill, closed solid waste landfills, recycling facilities, transfer station, citizen service areas that support solid waste activities and other facilities as directed by the Solid Waste Manager.

Amendment #1 will provide for an increase to the billing rate per hour for one consultant, SCS Engineers of Tampa. SCS Engineers has requested an increase in hourly rates due to inflation and other factors. The rate increase information is contained in the backup material. The proposed rate schedule will be effective after approval and will apply to future Work Orders awarded to SCS Engineers. After reviewing the request the revised hourly rates are considered within fair market value for engineering services.

Environmental Services Department/Solid Waste Division and Fiscal Services/Purchasing and Contracts Division recommend the Board to approve the request and authorize the Chairman to execute the Amendment as prepared by the County Attorney's Office.

**FIRST AMENDMENT TO ENGINEERING SERVICES AGREEMENT (PS-586-01/BJC)
SOLID WASTE MANAGEMENT**

THIS FIRST AMENDMENT is made and entered into this _____ day of _____, 20____ and is to that certain Agreement made and entered into on the 12th day of June, 2001 between **SCS ENGINEERS**, whose address is 3012 U.S. Highway 301, Suite 700, Tampa, Florida 33619-2242, hereinafter referred to as "ENGINEER," and **SEMINOLE COUNTY**, a political subdivision of the State of Florida, whose address is Seminole County Services Building, 1101 East First Street, Sanford, Florida 32771, hereinafter referred to as "COUNTY".

W I T N E S S E T H:

WHEREAS, the ENGINEER and COUNTY entered into the above-referenced Agreement on June 12, 2001 for engineering services; and

WHEREAS, the parties desire to amend the Agreement so as to enable both parties to continue to enjoy the mutual benefits it provides; and

WHEREAS, Section 23 of the Agreement provides that any amendments shall be valid only when expressed in writing and duly signed by the parties,

NOW, THEREFORE, in consideration of the mutual understandings and agreements contained herein, the parties agree to amend the Agreement as follows:

1. Exhibit "C" of the Agreement is deleted and Exhibit "C" attached hereto is substituted therefore.

2. Except as herein modified, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for the term of the Agreement, as originally set forth in said Agreement.
