MOTION/RECOMMENDATION:

Select and approve a POW / MIA sign format for installation along Airport Boulevard from U.S. Highway 17/92 to the Orlando Sanford Airport property boundary.

BACKGROUND:

At the May 13, 2003 meeting, Seminole County Board of County Commissioners took action to designate a POW / MIA memorial roadway segment along Airport Boulevard between U.S. Highway 17/92 and the Orlando Sanford Airport property boundary. The memorial roadway segment will be identified with signage at appropriate locations. Three POW / MIA signage alternatives are presented for Board selection and approval. Two of the three alternatives are original designs from Seminole County staff. The third alternative (black background) is the traditional design used commonly throughout the United States. Should the Board desire, Seminole County's logo can be added to the selected design prior to installation.
