**BACKGROUND:**

In accordance with Chapter 17 of the Seminole County Code, and Chapter 410 of the Florida Statutes, a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (COPCN) is required to provide emergency medical transport services in Seminole County.

**CURRENT STATUS:**


- Florida Hospital (COPCN Expires 6/14/05)

**FEE STRUCTURE:**

The fee for non-emergency transportation shall not exceed the amount as approved by the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners.

**PERFORMANCE STANDARDS:**

Agency shall meet or exceed the requirements of Chapters 401 and 395 of the Florida Statutes and Chapter 64E-2 of Florida Administrative Code.

**FIRST RENEWAL OF NON-EXCLUSIVE  
AMBULANCE FRANCHISE AGREEMENT**

**WHEREAS,** the PROVIDER and COUNTY entered into the above-referenced Agreement on June 13, 2003, for non-exclusive ambulance services; and

1. **RENEWAL.** The Agreement is hereby renewed for the term of one (1) year from June 14, 2005 through June 13, 2006, unless terminated sooner as provided for therein.

2. Except as herein modified, all terms and conditions of the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect for the term of this Renewal, as originally set forth in said Agreement.
