1. Transmittal of the text amendment to the "Greenways and Trails Master Plan" and "Greenways and Trails Linkages" plan of the Seminole County Comprehensive Plan to the Department of Community Affairs for review.
2. Denial of the text amendment to the "Greenways and Trails Master Plan" and "Greenways and Trails Linkages" plan of the Seminole County Comprehensive Plan.
3. Continue the request to a time and date certain.

**BACKGROUND:**

County Engineering staff are proposing modifications to the adopted "Greenways and Trails Master Plan" and "Greenways and Trails Linkages" plan of the Seminole County Comprehensive Plan. The changes are proposed to provide up-to-date program plans, but also to resolve differences between the two maps which have evolved over the years.

The proposed changes include:

*Realignments of trail corridors to reflect updated project plans:*

1. The Kewannee Trail alignment has been modified to show its southerly connection to SR 436.
2. A segment of the Flagler Trail south of SR 46 has been modified to show the current proposed route.

*Reclassification of trails to more accurately reflect their intended function:*

The Flagler Trail was previously classified as a Major Wilderness Trail with a “showcase trail” overlay. The overlay has been deleted.

*Deletion of segments which staff have determined will likely not be feasible to pursue, and addition of new proposed segments.*

1. A segment of minor trail along Sanford Avenue, south from East Lake Mary Boulevard to Lake Jesup, has been deleted.
2. A segment of minor trail along Orange Boulevard from Oregon Avenue to SR 46 has been deleted.
3. Deletion of a potential route along a power line right of way in the easternmost portion of the county.
4. Addition of a proposed minor trail from Geneva east to Lake Harney.
5. Addition to the “Trails and Greenways Linkages” plan of an existing minor trail along Primera Blvd.

*Provide increased clarification via an enhanced “Key” to the maps as well as deletion of information which made the maps difficult to interpret:*

1. Routes of power lines have been deleted.
2. City boundaries have been added.
3. The “keys” on the two maps have been modified to utilize the same symbols and trails classifications.

#### **STAFF RECOMMENDATION:**

Staff recommends the Board of County Commissioners transmit the text amendment, as proposed, to the Department of Community Affairs for review.


#### **LOCAL PLANNING AGENCY/PLANNING & ZONING COMMISSION RECOMMENDATION:**





