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**MOTION/RECOMMENDATION:**

Discuss and set tentative proposed millage rates to be included on TRIM notifications and authorize staff to schedule and advertise two public hearings for the adoption of the tentative and final operating and capital budget for FY 2005/2006.

**BACKGROUND:**

Section 200.65, Florida Statutes requires the Board of County Commissioners to set a proposed millage rate to be used by the Property Appraiser on the Notice of Proposed Property Taxes (TRIM notice) mailed to property owners in August.

County Manager's Proposed Budget recommends the following millages for FY 2005/06:

Countywide .....	4.9989
Unincorporated Roads MSTU .....	.1228
Fire MSTU.....	2.6334
Natural Lands Voted Debt.....	.0770
Trails Development Voted Debt .....	.1271
Total .....	7.9592

The Countywide, Road and Fire millages are recommended to be held constant at FY 2004/05 levels.

The proposed millage rates may be increased at the first public hearing only if each property owner is notified by first class mail within three days of the first public hearing. Millage rates may not be increased at the second public hearing. The proposed millage rates represent a 9.85% increase over the aggregate roll-back millage rate of 6.09030.

It is statutorily required for this information to be submitted to the Property Appraiser no later than August 4<sup>th</sup>.
