**RESOLUTION  
THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS  
ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE  
BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF  
SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON THE 8th DAY  
OFAUGUST, A.D., 2006.**

**WHEREAS**, the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County Florida have consented to join the United Cerebral Palsy of Central Florida in honoring Krista Pohorenc for her work as a community servant, a mentor of children, a motivational speaker, and a local hero; and

**WHEREAS**, in addition to spending countless hours volunteering for two nonprofit organizations as a teacher's aide and counselor for United Cerebral Palsy of Central Florida and the J. Douglas Williams YMCA in Lake Mary; and

**WHEREAS**, when Krista Pohorenc learned about nine-year-old Johnny Wilson's successful San Francisco Bay swim to raise funds for Hurricane Katrina victims, she set her sights on training to do the same for children with disabilities, despite being diagnosed shortly after her birth with Down syndrome twenty-two years ago; and

**WHEREAS**, Krista Pohorenc is now in training; for the most challenging swim of her life on September 30, 2006: a bone-chilling 1.4 mile open-water from Alcatraz Island to San Francisco Aquatic Park to raise funds for UCP of Central Florida and raise awareness about the importance of early childhood intervention services for special needs children; and

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the Board of County Commissioners do hereby proclaim and recognize Krista Pohorenc for her energetic spirit, her inspiration, her compassionate heart, and her love of swimming, using her talents to help children with special needs
