**RESOLUTION**

**THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT  
THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE  
COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON THE 27th DAY  
OF SEPTEMBER, AD., 2005.**

**WHEREAS**, the Florida Department of Environmental Protection has designated the month of October 2005 as "Florida Greenways and Trails Month"; and

**WHEREAS**, Seminole County has a long standing commitment to the establishment of greenways and trails as envisioned by the \$25 million bond referendum approved by the citizens to fund the development of a network of urban and wilderness trails throughout the County; and

**WHEREAS**, the Seminole County Greenways and Trails Master Plan identifies an interconnected system of trails and greenways that provide safe connections to our schools, Natural Lands, parks and neighborhoods throughout Seminole County; and

**WHEREAS**, community-based partnerships are essential to the success of the Florida Greenways and Trails System, and many public and private entities with Seminole County are actively involved with projects that are connecting Seminole County communities with greenways and trails.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED**, that the Board of County Commissioners do hereby proclaim October as Greenways and Trails Month and encourage all citizens to participate in enhancing Florida's greenways and trails for current and future generations.
