RESOLUTION

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON THE 28TH DAY OF SEPTEMBER, A.D., 2004.

WHEREAS, public transportation is making a real difference in the daily lives of individuals and households in the City of Sanford, County of Seminole and the State of Florida; and

WHEREAS, public transportation is vital to the quality of life and economic well-being of all citizens of; and,

WHEREAS, workers, school children, senior citizens, people with disabilities, and those unable to afford an automobile use public transportation to gain access to jobs, schools, medical facilities, and other fundamental services; and,

WHEREAS, public transportation helps lead the nation towards its goals and policies of protecting the environment, conserving energy, and providing for the health, safety and security of its citizens; and,
