

13. Report of an Emergency Purchase Order (EPO) to replace diesel piping at the Five Points Fuel Island, with Guardian Fueling Technologies, Inc., Sanford, FL (\$70,000.00)

An Emergency Purchase Order was issued to replace the broken diesel piping at the Five Points Fuel Island. The flex pipe that transfers fuel from the storage tanks to the dispensers burst and had to be replaced quickly; otherwise, no fuel would have been dispensed from this location. Moreover, there was a strong possibility of a fuel spill that would have hampered county-wide clean-up efforts after Hurricane Charley.

In accordance with Chapter 220, sec 220.41, an Emergency Purchase Order (EPO) was processed and a copy of the EPO is attached in the back-up.

Emergency Purchase Order #11353 to Guardian Fueling Technologies, Inc., Sanford, FL, was processed in the amount of \$70,000.00 on August 31, 2004.





