RESOLUTION

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON THE 14TH DAY OF OCTOBER, A.D., 2003.

WHEREAS, LYNX, Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority is making a real difference in the daily lives of individuals and households in Orange, Seminole and Osceola Counties; and

WHEREAS, public transportation is vital to the quality of life and economic well-being of all citizens; and

WHEREAS, workers, school children, senior citizens, people with disabilities, and those unable to afford an automobile use public transportation to gain access to jobs, schools, medical facilities, and other fundamental services; and

WHEREAS, public transportation helps lead the nation towards its goals and policies of protecting the environment, conserving energy, and providing for the health, safety and security of its citizens; and

WHEREAS, public transportation enables people from all walks of life to access opportunities that allow them to accomplish what is important to them, making the community stronger and more vibrant; and

WHEREAS, Central Florida Regional Transportation Authority, aka LYNX and the American Public Transportation Association have declared October 16, 2003, to be COMMUNITIES IN MOTION DAY and have called upon all citizens to join in a nationwide effort to promote public transportation's benefits.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County proclaim October 16, 2003, as COMMUNITIES IN MOTION DAY, and we call upon citizens to support public transportation and COMMUNITIES IN MOTION DAY.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County encourages the citizens of Seminole County to become more active in education and advocacy efforts to promote the vital role that public transportation plays in Seminole County, Florida and across the United States.
