WHEREAS, it is the most common cause of dementia and the fourth
leading cause of death in the United States; and

WHEREAS, almost five (5) million Americans have been diagnosed with
the disease and more than 40,000 of them reside in Central Florida.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the members of the Board
of County Commissioners do hereby proclaim November, 2003 as "Alzheimer
Awareness Month" and November 1, 2003 as "Alzheimer and Dementia
Awareness Day".
