RESOLUTION

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, ON THE 7th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2006.

WHEREAS, Dennis Dolgner has served the citizens of Seminole County as Administrator of the Seminole County Port Authority, located on the St. John's River, since September, 1978; and

WHEREAS, during the early 90s, Dennis contributed significantly to the development of Seminole County's first economic development strategy; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Sanford is debt free and has contributed \$1,590,000 over the past eight years to Seminole County; and

WHEREAS, utilizing the highest business practices and ethical standards, the Port of Sanford has grown to 455,196 square feet and 71 businesses and has contributed significantly to the overall economic vitality of the County; and

WHEREAS, under Mr. Dolgner's leadership, in 1996 the Port Authority developed a new generation of facilities called the Central Florida Business Incubation Center through a joint partnership with Seminole County and Seminole Community College; and

WHEREAS, in January of 2006, the final phase of the Small Business Center was completed, the 27,000 square foot facility can serve up to 14 clients with 1,500 and 3,000 square foot units and was 89% leased when the certificate of occupancy was issued; and

WHEREAS, the Port of Sanford has been a leader in the development of flexible space for small and emerging businesses since 1977 and continues this tradition today with 244,320 square feet dedicated exclusively to small business.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that Seminole County Board of County Commissioners wish to extend our sincere gratitude to Dennis Dolgner for his 32 years of dedicated service and leadership to the citizens of Seminole County and wish him well in his future endeavors.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that this Resolution be spread upon the Official Minutes by the Clerk to the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County, Florida.
