RESOLUTION

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA ON THE 7th DAY OF NOVEMBER, A.D., 2006.

WHEREAS, DR. E. ANN MCGEE, has faithfully served as President of Seminole Community College (SCC) since 1996, introducing powerful curriculum to elevate the caliber of SCC's associate degree programs and implementing numerous innovative career training initiatives to serve Central Florida's escalating workforce demands; and

WHEREAS, DR. ANN MCGEE has realized her vision of an expanded SCC to include doubling in size the Sanford/Lake Mary and Oviedo campuses, with a satellite campus in Altamonte Springs and the Center for Economic Development in Heathrow scheduled to open in the near future; and

WHEREAS, DR. MCGEE has tirelessly championed equitable funding for Florida's 28 community colleges, successfully securing a greater share of the legislature's budget funds; and

WHEREAS, DR. ANN MCGEE has participated in national educational associations as well as national and statewide postsecondary education boards and associations including the Community College Leadership Initiative Consortium, Florida State University Board of Trustees, both the American and Florida Association of Colleges & Universities, International Conference on Teaching & Leadership Excellence, Florida Council for Resource Development, Florida Department of Education's 2003 Chancellor's Leadership Seminar, Metro-Orlando Economic Development Commission, Workforce Central Florida Board of Directors, Community College Survey of Student Engagement, Higher Education Resource Development Institute, and the United States Air Force War Academy; and

WHEREAS, DR. ANN MCGEE has been the recipient of numerous awards including the 1994 *South Florida Magazine* "Woman of Distinction Award", Florida Phi Theta Kappa "Distinguished Service" and "Distinguished Alumna" awards in 2000 and the "Shirley B. Gordon Award of Distinction" in 2005, Orlando Business Journal's "Top 100 Most Influential People in Central Florida" in 2001 and 2002 and 2004 and the "Women Who Mean Business Award" in 2001, and the Seminole County Regional Chamber of Commerce "Lifetime Achievement Award" in 2004 ; and

WHEREAS, DR. ANN MCGEE was recently recognized for her significant contributions to education by the Association of Community College Trustees and received the "Marie Y. Martin Chief Executive Officer Award"; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to acknowledge DR. MCGEE as the top community college CEO and express its appreciation on behalf of the citizens of Seminole County, Florida to DR. MCGEE for her dedication to promoting excellence in education.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County, Florida that this Resolution be spread upon the Official Minutes by the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for the County of Seminole, and that this Resolution be presented to DR.
