THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY FLORIDA, ON THE 7th DAY OF NOVEMBER, 2006

WHEREAS, on January 8, 2002 President George W. Bush signed the *No Child Left Behind* Act giving our schools historic education reform based on strong accountability for results, more freedom for states and communities, encouragement proven education methods and more choices for parents regarding educational opportunities; and

WHEREAS, the *No Child Left Behind* - Blue Ribbon Schools Program honors public and private K-12 schools that are either academically superior in their states or that demonstrate dramatic gains in student achievement; and

WHEREAS, 250 schools were recently named nationally as 2006 *No Child Left Behind* - Blue Ribbon Schools being singled out for national honors by reflecting the goals of our nation's new education reforms for high standards and accountability; and

WHEREAS, the 2006 *No Child Left Behind* - Blue Ribbon Schools will be honored at an awards ceremony in Washington, D.C. November 9th and 10th; and

WHEREAS, St. Mary Magdalene Catholic School, Altamonte Springs was one of twelve schools named state-wide and the only Seminole County school receiving this honor.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County, Florida hereby commends the administrators, teachers and students at the St. Mary Magdalene Catholic School for receiving the

2006 No Child Left Behind – Blue Ribbon School Award.
