MOTION/RECOMMENDATION:

Approval by the Board of County Commissioners to utilize \$2,000 in Law Enforcement Trust Funds for the following: a contribution to the Boys and Girls Club of Central Florida, West Sanford Branch in support of the Club's drug prevention program and to the Girls and Boys Town of Central Florida in support of their new 16 bed girl's shelter.

BACKGROUND:

1. **\$1,000 contribution to the Boys and Girls Club of Central Florida, West Sanford Branch.** The Boys and Girls Club of Central Florida, West Sanford Branch operates a drug prevention program aimed at children in elementary and middle schools. The goal of the program is to inform children of the dangers inherent in the use of drugs and tobacco. The program includes resources and motivational speakers, trips, incentives and model social activities that demonstrate the ability for children to have fun while staying drug free. The Sheriff's Office is a firm supporter of community based drug prevention programs and desires to contribute \$1,000 in Law Enforcement Trust Fund monies to the Boys and Girls Club in support of their drug prevention program.

2. **\$1,000 contribution to the Girls and Boys Town of Central Florida.** The Girls and Boys Town of Central Florida is a not for profit agency based in Oviedo. The organization is nearing completion of a 16 bed girl's shelter, which will enable services to be provided to approximately 300 girls between the ages of 10 and 18 each year. The Girls and Boys Town is seeking financial assistance in outfitting the shelter with furniture and other household items. Since the shelter serves high-risk youths and represents an important need in the County, the Sheriff's Office would like to contribute \$1,000 in Law Enforcement Trust Fund monies to the shelter.
