

Resolution No. 04-R-**RESOLUTION**

**THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA ON THE 9TH DAY OF NOVEMBER A.D., 2004.**

**WHEREAS**, DARYL G. MCLAIN, a fourth generation Floridian and life-long resident of Sanford who has been instantly recognizable by one of his many cowboy hats, has served the citizens and residents of Seminole County with the highest level of integrity, dedication and expertise during his terms of office from November 1992 to November 2004 as the Commissioner for Seminole County District 5; and

**WHEREAS**, DARYL MCLAIN has been a strong proponent of defining and enforcing rural boundaries, restricting development and preserving the environmentally sensitive Wekiva River Protection Area, and has in fact served as an appointee of Governor Jeb Bush to both the Wekiva Basin Task Force and the Wekiva River Coordinating Committee in their studies and deliberations regarding possible alignment of a bypass beltway through the Wekiva Area from *Interstate 4* to Lake County; and

**WHEREAS**, COMMISSIONER MCLAIN has staunchly supported the establishment of parks and wilderness areas, the purchase of ecologically sensitive properties through the County's Natural Lands Program to preserve wilderness habitats and the wildlife that live there, and the development and expansion of our system of trails and greenways so that our residents might continue to enjoy and be educated in Seminole County's unique and fast-disappearing natural recreational resources; and

**WHEREAS**, DARYL MCLAIN has worked to improve conditions for residents in the Midway area including road paving, installation of stormwater and drainage systems, and construction of sidewalks, pushed for legal and fair agriculture exemptions, and opposed high-density development along rural Celery Avenue and the historic Indian Mound area; and

**WHEREAS**, COMMISSIONER MCLAIN has supported the courts and judges, encouraged awareness of the Guardian Ad Litem Program in Seminole County to protect the interests of the young or disabled who cannot do that for themselves, honored Viet Nam POWs/MIAs, active duty military personnel and Veterans through highway designations and resolutions; and

**WHEREAS**, DARYL MCLAIN, during his twelve years on the Board, has faithfully represented Seminole County by serving two terms on the Florida Association of Counties (FAC) Board of Directors and as liaison on many of the Commission's Boards and Committees including LYNX, MetroPlan Orlando, Central Florida Zoological Society, Value Adjustment Board, Risk Management Executive Committee and Envision Seminole; and

**WHEREAS**, The Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County, Florida wish also to recognize COMMISSIONER MCLAIN for his three consecutive terms, FY 2001-02, 2002-03 and 2003-04 as Chairman of the Seminole County Board of County Commissioners during which period he distinguished himself by conducting excellent County Commission meetings.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Board of Commissioners of Seminole County, Florida that this Resolution be spread upon the Official Minutes by the Clerk of the Circuit Court in and for the County of Seminole in appreciation of the service to the citizens and residents of Seminole County by DARYL MCLAIN as District Five Commissioner for the years 1992 through 2004.

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that this Resolution be presented to DARYL G. MCLAIN with our sincere best wishes for his continued good health, happiness and success in future endeavors on behalf of the citizens of Seminole County.
