MOTION/RECOMMENDATION:

Authorization to schedule and advertise a public hearing for the purpose of adopting a resolution establishing Seminole County's intent to adopt the uniform method of collecting non-advalorem assessments. Request date of February 10, 2004.

BACKGROUND:

Pursuant to Section 197.3632, Florida Statutes, counties are required to advertise their intent to use the "uniform" method of collecting all non-advalorem assessments including, but not limited to, assessments for water service, road paving and drainage, sidewalks, street lighting, landscaping, maintenance, garbage/trash collection and disposal, and stormwater management. The local government is required to publish such notice in a paper of general circulation for four (4) consecutive weeks preceding a public hearing. A resolution is required to be adopted at a public hearing prior to March 1, 2004.
