PURPOSE: Seminole County has entered into an intergovernmental agreement with the St. Johns River Water Management District, approved by the Seminole County BCC on May 11, 2004, to accomplish mitigation work at the County's Electrical Worker's Site (Natural Lands). The District will provide the funding to knock down and level 80% of a levee constructed during the 1950's and Seminole County will administer the project. Seminole County bid the project and Turnbull Environmental was chosen as the contractor for the project with a bid of \$42,500. Seminole County has received a check from the District for the full amount.

ACTION: Approval and authorization for the Chairman to execute Budget Amendment Resolution.
