RESOLUTION

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED AT THE REGULAR MEETING OF THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA ON THE 14th DAY OF DECEMBER, A.D., 2004.

WHEREAS, LOIS STABLER has faithfully served Seminole County, its citizens and residents with the highest level of integrity and dedication for more than seventeen years; and

WHEREAS, LOIS STABLER moved from Indiana in 1987 with her family and began her career with Seminole County Government in September 1987 in the Public Works Department as a Clerk-Typist, was promoted within a year to the position of Secretary to the Director, and subsequently served four Public Works Directors in that capacity: Larry Sellers, Tony Van Derworp, James Marino, and Gary Johnson; and

WHEREAS, LOIS STABLER served on the Safety Committee, Employee Picnic Committee, Employee Suggestion Box Committee, Small Department Communications Team as part of the Seminole County Strategic Planning Initiative, United Way Campaign Coordinator for Public Works Department, Chairman of the Volunteer Appreciation Dinner through National County Government Week, and is a 2004 Graduate of *The Academy*; and

WHEREAS, the Board of County Commissioners wishes to express its appreciation on behalf of county staff and the citizens of Seminole County, Florida to LOIS STABLER and desires to acknowledge her conscientious and faithful service upon her retirement from Seminole County Government.
