

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT ITS REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF DECEMBER 8, 2009.

WHEREAS, under the authority contained in Sections 336.05(1) and 336.05(2), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners of Seminole County may name and rename streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received to name the realigned right-of-way south of West State Road 434. The street naming is within the recorded plat of Sanlando Springs, Plat Book 5, Page 19, Tract 28, Block E, abutting Lot 1; Silver Springs Square, Plat Book 75, Pages 44 and 45, Lot 1; Pebbles, Plat Book 31, Page 97, Unplotted area; in Section 2, Township 21, Range 29, Public Records of Seminole County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, the realigned unnamed right-of-way described above lies within the unincorporated portion of Seminole County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, naming this realigned unnamed right-of-way will help to eliminate confusion, facilitate improved emergency access and ability of the public to locate streets and roads within Seminole County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, this change is consistent with overall County plans for street renaming, addressing and the 911 system,




