

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT THEIR REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF DECEMBER 14, 2010.

WHEREAS, under the authority contained in Sections 336.05(1) and 336.05(2), Florida Statutes, the Board of County Commissioners may name and rename streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received from the Property Owners on Talman Mews Court to rename Talman Mews Court located in the recorded plat of Talman Mews, Plat Book 67 Page 55 in Talman Mews Phase 2, abutting lots 1 through 8 and tracts C and D in Section 25, Township 21 South, Range 30 East, Public Records of Seminole County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, Talman Mews Court is located wholly within unincorporated Seminole County; and

WHEREAS, renaming this street will help to eliminate confusion, facilitate improved emergency access and ability of the public to locate streets and roads within Seminole County, Florida; and


WHEREAS, this change is consistent with overall County plans for street renaming, naming, addressing and the 911 system,
