

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT THEIR REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF MARCH 27, 1990.

WHEREAS, under the authority contained in Section 336.05(1) and 336.05(2), Florida Statutes, The Board of County Commissioners may name and rename streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received to rename a street known as Echo Drive located within Alaquua III, Plat Book 42, Pages 2-8, Public Records of Seminole County, Florida.

WHEREAS, this name change will help to eliminate confusion, facilitate improved emergency access and ability of the public to locate streets and roads within Seminole County, and,

WHEREAS, this change is consistent with overall County plans for street naming, addressing and the E-911 system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that effective March 27, 1990, the following street is hereby changed from:

**Echo Drive to ALAQUA LAKES PARKWAY**
