

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT THEIR REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF NOVEMBER 13, 1990.

WHEREAS, under the authority contained in Section 336.05(1) and 336.05(2), Florida Statutes, The Board of County Commissioners may name and rename streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received to name a segment of the railroad bed known as Old State Road 13. This segment extends from Osceola Road to the Saint Johns River and abuts Parcels 7 and 7A in Section 31, Township 19, Range 33 and Parcels 2A and 15 in Section 36, Township 19, Range 32 in the Public Records of Seminole County, Florida; and

WHEREAS, naming this segment of this railroad bed will help to eliminate confusion, facilitate improved emergency access and ability of the public to locate streets and roads within Seminole County; and,

WHEREAS, this change is consistent with overall County plans for street naming, addressing and the E-911 system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that effective November 13, 1990, the segment of the railroad bed described herein will be named:

OSCEOLA FISH CAMP ROAD
