RESOLUTION NO. 90-R-373

SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT THEIR REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING ON DECEMBER 11, 1990.

WHEREAS, under the authority contained in Section 336.05 (1) and 336.05 (2), Florida Statutes, The Board of County Commissioners may name and rename streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received to rename a street named Rosseberry Lane within the Plat of Roseland Park, Plat Book 7 Page 51 (forming the western boundary of lots 2 through 19 and the eastern boundary of lots 20, 22 through 30, 35 and 43) and within the Plat of Roseland Park's First Addition, Plat Book 7, Page 66, (forming the western boundary of lots 1 through 5; the western and southern boundary of lot 6 and the eastern boundary of lot 7; the north eastern boundary of the park.), Public Records of Seminole County, Florida.

WHEREAS, this name change will help to eliminate confusion, facilitate improved emergency access and ability of the public to locate streets and roads within Seminole County, and,

WHEREAS, this change is consistent with overall County plans for street naming, addressing and the E-911 system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that effective December 11, 1990, the following street is hereby changed from:


**Rosebud Lane to Roseberry Lane**

Adopted this 11th day of December 1990.




