

THE FOLLOWING RESOLUTION WAS ADOPTED BY THE BOARD OF COUNTY COMMISSIONERS OF SEMINOLE COUNTY, FLORIDA, AT THEIR REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF JANUARY 23, 1990.

WHEREAS, under the authority contained in Section 336.05(1) and 336.05(2), Florida Statutes, The Board of County Commissioners may name and rename streets and roads; and

WHEREAS, a request has been received to name a street known as UNNAMED ROAD, which is located adjacent to the western boundary of lots 9, 8, 7, and 6 and the eastern boundary of lots 2, 3, 4, 5 within Thomas' Second Addition to Midway, Plat Book 11/Page 97 of the Public Records of Seminole County, Florida, to

WHEREAS, naming this street will help to eliminate confusion, facilitate improved emergency access and ability of the public to locate streets and roads within Seminole County, and,

WHEREAS, this naming is consistent with overall County plans for street naming, addressing and the E-911 system.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that effective January 23, 1990, this unnamed street is hereby named:


