Motion by Commissioner Swofford, seconded by Commissioner Gatchel and carried to authorize R.S. Brown, Zoning Director to attend a meeting at Florida State University on Zoning.

Mack N. Cleveland, Jr. Attorney was directed to write MR. BRYAN WILLIS, STATE AUDITOR concerning the unjustified criticism the Board Received in regard to Bids and Purchasing of certain equipment.
