AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF LONGWOOD, FLORIDA, CHANGING THE NAMES OF THE VARIOUS STREETS WITHIN THE CITY OF LONGWOOD, FLORIDA

BE IT ENACTED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF LONGWOOD, FLORIDA:

1. That the names of the following set forth streets within the City of Longwood, Florida, are changed so that henceforth

they will be named and designated as follows:

- 12th Street shall be 12th Avenue
- 14th Street shall be 14th Avenue
- 13th Street shall be 13th Avenue
- 9th Street shall be 9th Avenue
- 8th Street shall be 8th Avenue
- 7th Street shall be 7th Avenue
- Jessup Street shall be Jessup Avenue
- Church Street shall be Church Avenue
- Warren Street shall be Warren Avenue
- Bay Street shall be Bay Avenue
- Pine Street shall be Pine Avenue
- Short Street shall be Short Avenue
- Evergreen Street shall be Evergreen Avenue
- Maine Street shall be Maine Avenue
- Lake Street shall be Lake Avenue
- Tullis Street shall be Tullis Avenue
- Florida Street shall be Florida Avenue

- That portion of 12th Street shall be 12th Avenue
- That portion of Orange Street shall be Orange Avenue
- That portion of Palmetto Street shall be Palmetto Avenue
- That portion of Magnolia Street shall be Magnolia Avenue

- Highland Avenue shall be Highland Street
- Wayman Avenue shall be Wayman Street
- Myrtle Avenue shall be Myrtle Street
- East Lake Avenue shall be East Lake Street
- Wilma Avenue shall be Wilma Street
- West Lake Avenue shall be West Lake Street
- Sarah Avenue shall be Sarah Street
- Charles Avenue shall be Charles Street
- Longwood Avenue shall be Longwood Street

- That portion of Grant Avenue shall be Grant Street
- That portion of Oak Avenue shall be Oak Street
- That portion of Oleander Avenue shall be Oleander Street

- Florida Avenue shall be Land Avenue
- Molnar Street shall be Sanlando Springs Drive

2. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and adoption.

3. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

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of State Road 600, North of State Road 434 and South of road right-of-way conveyed to Seminole County by deed recorded in Official Records Book 1, Page 71 in said clerk's office (Church Street). Said parcel of land being particularly described as follows: BEGINNING at intersection of West right-of-way of State Road 15-600 and Northerly right-of-way of State Road 434 (known as Longwood-Wagner Road) run West along the North right-of-way of State Road 434 a distance of 150 feet to point, thence Northerly on a line parallel to the West right-of-way line of State Road 15-600 a distance of 150 feet to a point; thence Easterly on a line parallel to the North right-of-way line of State Road 434 a distance of 150 feet to a point in the Westerly right-of-way line of State Road 15-600; thence South along the West right-of-way line to State Road 15-600 a distance of 150 feet to a point of beginning.

(f) All that portion of the right of way of U. S. Highway 17-92 which abuts any of the above-described property.

2. Any Ordinance or parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon its final passage and adoption.
