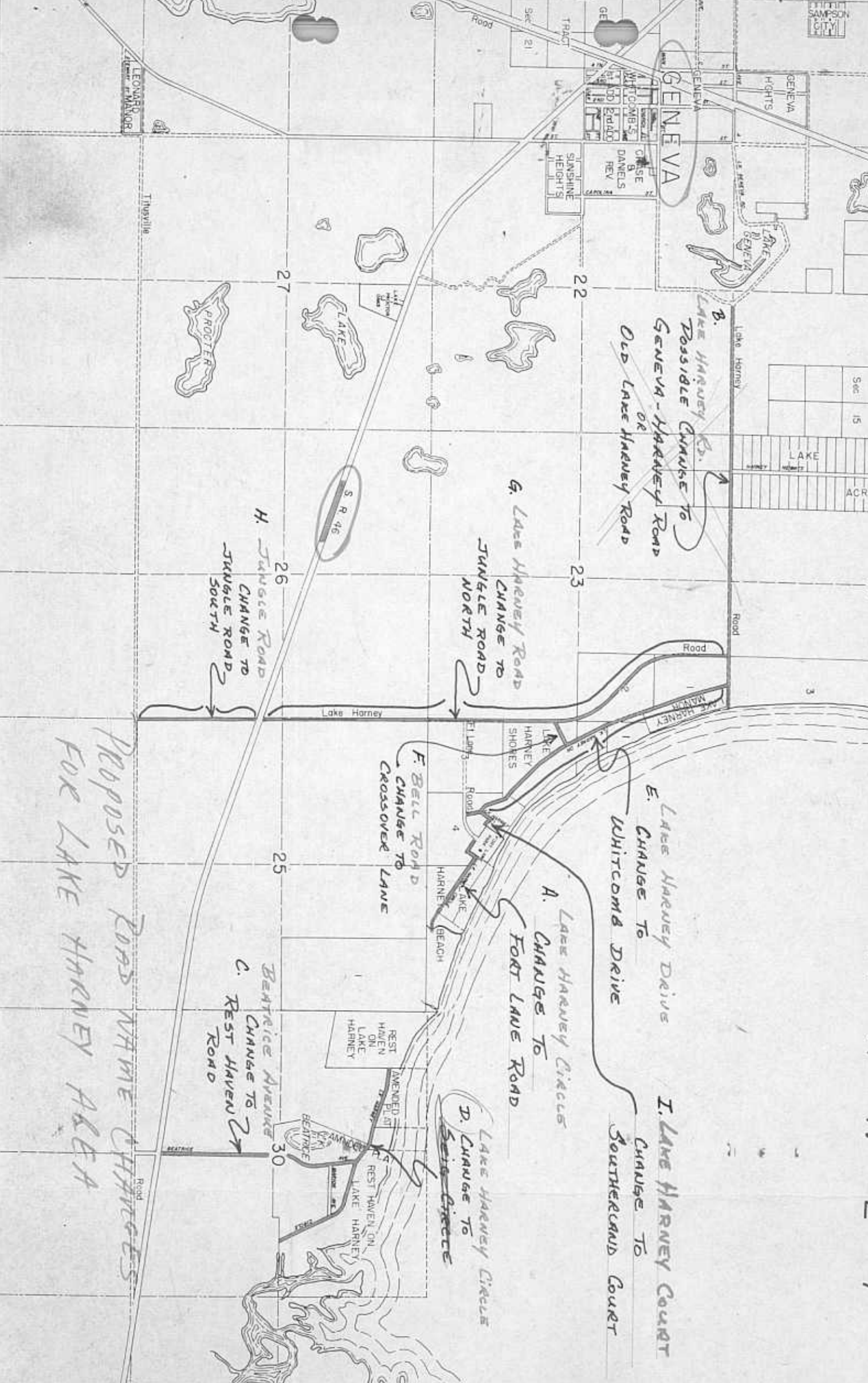

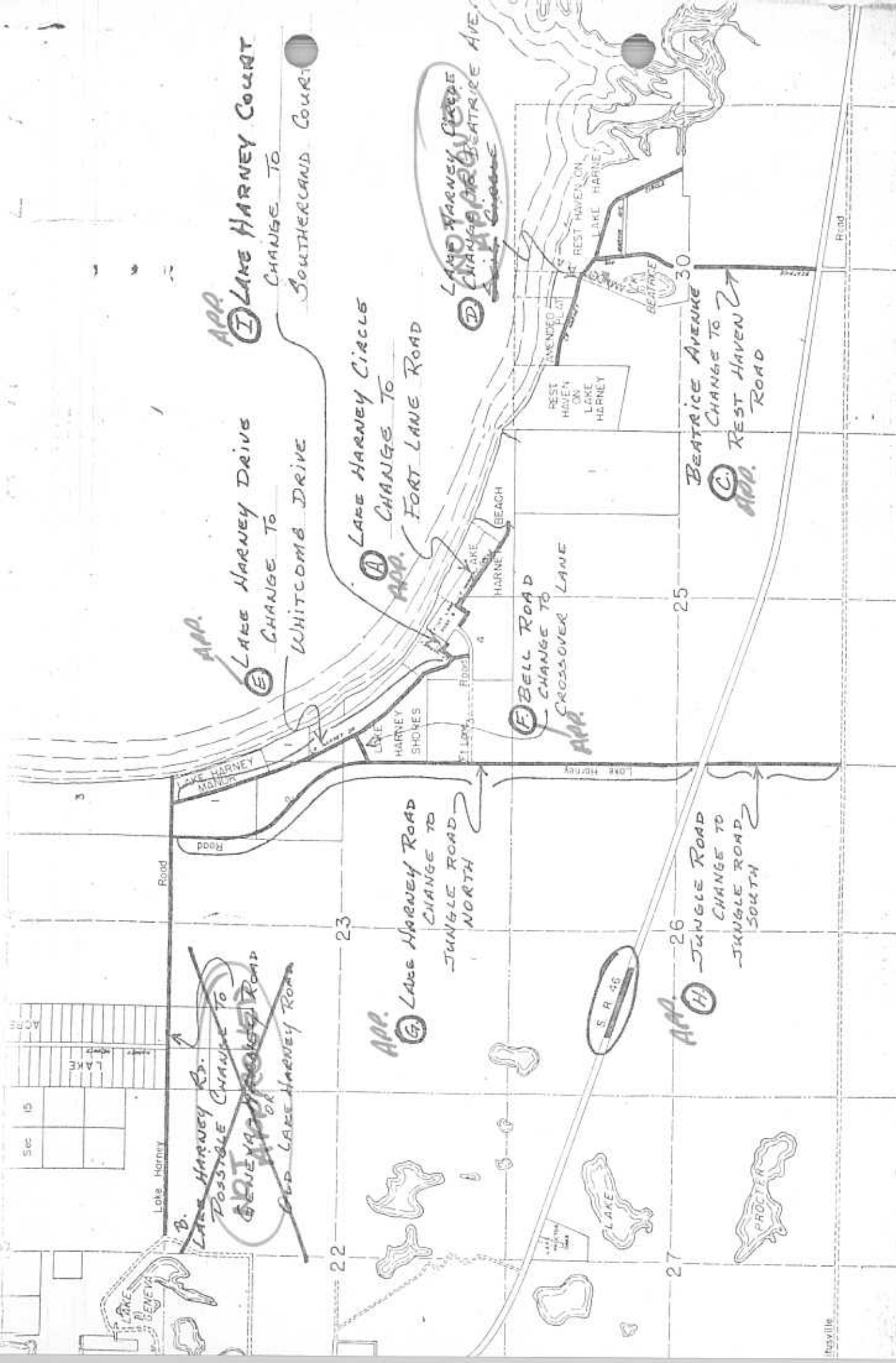

Dear Mr. Dwyer:

I received your memorandum on renaming some of the streets and roads in the Lake Harney areas of Geneva and was somewhat surprised at some of the proposals.

I was on the committee to assist in renaming some of these streets to eliminate the obvious confusion the existing names. I suppose some of the confusion exists due to county road signs indicating street names that apparently do not agree with current maps such as the road off Highway 46 going into the Rest Haven Subdivision. The street sign indicates that road is "Rest Haven Road" whereas obviously your map has it as "Beatrice Avenue". I, incidentally, agree that it should be "Rest Haven Road" as marked.

That portion of "Lake Harney Circle" within the Resthaven Subdivision that the proposal recommends "Beatrice Avenue" is the one I take exception to. While working with Lorraine Whiting on the aforementioned committee, we had recommended the name of "Sieg Circle" for this street. I submitted a memo to Lorraine explaining the rationale involved in this selection of which I feel you have a copy.

I certainly feel that the Sieg family name is more significant and historical than the first name of the wife of the person who owned the property at one time in history and to my knowledge did little or no civic duties to better the community. The amazing results of community development achieved through the untiring efforts of the Siegs should not go unnoticed but should be exemplified by a street named in their honor.
