Guys, I just got a call from FDOT and Jacobs. They wanted to discuss the stretch of roadway described above. It seems they are working on this section and had talked to John years ago about upgrading the lighting. I know we have been doing this upgrade (like we did in Fern Park) and wanted to let you know that the request needs to come in so CRA can pay for the upgrade. David from FDOT would handle the LFA and we would need to follow the same process we did for this project.

Brett, can you please submit a request like last time? There will be about 200 lights at a cost of about 2k per light for upgrade. Also, Jacobs has asked for the spec on the lights we used in Fern Park. Can you please forward that to me and I will get it to them?

Bill, if you want to do landscaping on this stretch.....they have offered to spec sleeves for irrigation. However, they want to know what you plan to do....and whether or not you want some sort of paver/stamped concrete.

I am hoping you guys would be willing to have a brief meeting to go over this. Can you give me some dates/times that work for you early next week?
