### **17-92 CRA Grant - Paw Park Additional Funding Request**

The City of Sanford would like to request an amendment to the existing 17-92 CRA "Paw Park Improvement" grant in the amount of \$50,000. The project is currently underway and several issues have arisen during the construction process.

#### *Item #1 – Park Benches and Trash Bins*

It was anticipated that the existing park benches and trash bins would be refurbished and re-installed when the project was complete. Unfortunately, while undertaking the refurbishment of these elements, it became apparent that the benches and cans are past their useful life cycle. Refurbishment of these elements is estimated to be almost as costly as purchase of new benches and bins. Preliminary estimates put the cost of these features at approximately \$20K.

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#### *Item #2 – Park Lighting*

The existing park lighting is in working condition and has been left undisturbed while construction activities have occurred. The light fixtures were installed approximately 15 years ago on a grid pattern in the park, prior to the installation of walkways throughout the park. A dedicated area for small dogs has been created, which extends along the entire south end of the park. This area has new walkways where none previously existed. The configuration and number of existing lights in the park are not adequate to light the new pathways, potentially posing a safety issue. Preliminary estimates for relocation of existing fixtures and installation of additional fixtures is approximately \$30K.

Attached are in progress photos of the park rehabilitation. The park unveiling will include a citizen participation public art project with mural art that is being privately funded. It is anticipated that the park will receive a great deal of positive exposure when it re-opens, which is currently scheduled for September 2016.
