The information included in this Addendum revises, clarifies, or supplements the specifications and other provisions of the contract documents and is considered part and parcel to the RFP/BID Package.

Questions asked at the Pre-Bid Conference for BD-1137-06/BHJ – Kiosk and Entrance Signs for Seminole County Natural Lands

Q – Do you expect #1 or #2 lumber for use on the construction of the kiosks?

A – The County requests #2 lumber for construction.

Q - Will the County accept High Density Urethane as an alternative to the phenolic resin?

A - Yes, please see the attached bid form (The County requests that the Bidder submit the price proposal with both submittal options).

Q - Where are the kiosks to be located?

A - Lake Jesup Wilderness Area: Rear area of the park (before the trail starts), vehicle accessible.

Black Bear Wilderness Area: In the parking area, vehicle accessible.

Black Hammock Wilderness Area: 100 feet down the trail, vehicle accessible.

Q – What size fasteners are to be used for the construction of each kiosk?

A – Simpson Strapping #25 or equivalent (please see technical specifications).

Q – What is the budgeted amount for the project?

A – The budgeted amount for the project is \$25,000.00.

Q – Do the smaller connected signs under the large wilderness area sign have to be replaced?

A – No, the small signs will need to be removed and given back Seminole County for reuse.

Q – Does the wood treatment require ACQ?

A – Yes.

Q – Is the Contractor responsible for including address number signs on the entrance signs and map location boxes on the kiosks?

A- No, Seminole County will provide all necessary address signs and map location boxes.

- The Bid Form has been revised and attached to this addendum to reflect the allowance of the alternate material.

Failure to acknowledge receipt of this addendum on the submittal may result in disqualification of your bid response.
