Q - Could you please confirm the signage needed?

A - Number of signs: 7 Double Sided Signs 48" x 48 " x 2" (Geneva Wilderness Area, Lake Proctor Wilderness Area, Black Bear Wilderness Area, Chuluota Wilderness Area, Lake Jesup Wilderness Area, Black Hammock Wilderness Area, Econ River Wilderness Area). Graphics/ artwork are to be supplied by Seminole County.

Q – Are the Double Sided signs – 38"x9"x2" – constructed out of flat HPL (High Pressure Phenolic Laminate) required?

A – These small signs located underneath the large entrance signs will be provided and installed by Seminole County and are not to be included in the bid.

Q - An alternate option for dimensional sand-blasted, primed and painted HDU (High Density Urethane) will also accepted.

- A Yes, please see Addendum #2.
- Q Please also confirm that the Lucite material to be used throughout the project is to be 1/8" thick.
- A Please go with industry standard for the thickness of the material.
- Phenolic Resin and High Density Urethane will be the only signage material accepted by Seminole County.
