


2020 Multimodal Transportation

Mixed Used Center & Development Corridors

Light rail alignments are preliminary in nature and are currently under study. It is anticipated that only one route north of SR 436 will be chosen. Any alignment north of SR 434 to Sanford is conceptual at this time.
