County Trail Discussion and updates

- Question concerning power line easement in Winter Springs. Possible trail corridor. Bryan will look into this.

#### **New Business:**

City of Sanford Trail Discussion

- Main trail focus for the City at this point The City is looking at Phase II design of the Goldsboro Trail going down the CSX railway to existing Riverwalk.
- Question from Mr. Goff concerning wide sidewalks and if they would be used in connections within City and gave Fern Creek as an example.
- Question regarding status of Riverwalk. City stated that issues regarding completion revolve around funding and FDOT agreements.
- Committee discussed educating the public and City Council of importance of trails.
- Mr. Goff suggested finding a legislative trail champion at the State level, ie. Constantine.
- Christine Dalton gave overview of future trail plans and the coordination with the CRA and Paw Park.

- How does the City get usage numbers in Parks? Through wear and visual counts. County has counter boxes.
- Mr. Williams mentioned that the Committee has noted the importance of connecting the riverwalk and that it is high on the priority list of the Committee.
- Mr. Hultin stated that their next step will be to bring the County interest level to the Public Works director who will then bring as briefing to Council Members.
