Old Business:

• Mr. Nipe gave an overview of the **Wekiva Parkway project** and discussed option for a trail-alongside and an alternate route as supported by the BCC. Letter was sent on behalf of the BCC to multiple agencies indicating this support.

New Business:

- City of Lake Mary Trail Discussion
 - The City is focusing on development with rail stations in downtown Lake Mary. The City wants to focus on connectivity of pedestrians to connector rail. The current FDOT plans do not show sidewalks from the station to Lake Mary Blvd. and the City has requested sidewalks be incorporated into FDOT design.
 - Lake Mary's- downtown gateway is focused on 4th Street in design. Country Club would be secondary due to County owned status and conflicts with proposed entry features.
 - The city is interested in utilizing rain gardens as drainage and is interested in feedback concerning funding for this project.
 - Mr. Goff discussed the committee focus on pursuing a referendum for parks and trails. Mr. Nipe presented the master plan indicating connectivity of trails through Sanford Walk to the Seminole Wekiva Trail. Mr. Nipe was asked to provide a copy of the master plan to John Amana.
 - Mr. Amana stated that a direct connection to the south to the Seminole Wekiva Trail is currently not wanted by residents. Discussion followed.
 - o There was discussion on the limitation of concepts connecting to the trail system.
