 - Approved the Boater Improvement Fund applications from Altamonte Springs, Casselberry and Sanford.
 - Approved the Seminole Wekiva Trail underpass. Funding is from sales taxes and impact fees.
 - Approved 10% assistance to Oviedo, approximately \$440,000, toward the Red Bug Lake Road and 426 overpass.

Mr. Abel informed that Commissioner Henley made a motion to have the Chairman send a letter to the City of Winter Springs requesting Winter Springs pull two land zoning issue items from the City's meeting agenda for further discussion at this time and encourage setting a joint meeting between the Winter Springs Commission and the County Commission and also look at opportunities to potentially do a land swap somewhere in Winter Springs for Jetta Point Park and a property that may be better suited for a park. The Commissioner's motion was seconded, discussed and approved. In essence they put a hold on Jetta Point Park. Much discussion followed. The Committee agreed to monitor the situation.
