The meeting was called to order at 7:30 a.m. and the minutes for August 2011 were approved.

NEW BUSINESS:

Jim Duby led a discussion on potential sites for the FYCCN effort to establish a Youth Conservation Center on County owned land. Jim gave an overview of the concept behind the movement explaining that the perfect location would allow the largest variety of outdoor related activities including hunting, fishing, shooting sports and archery to name a few. A map was handed out that depicts all Natural/Preserved lands in Seminole County. Two matrices were also provided, one listing current uses, constraints and advantages for each site and the other listing the preferred activities per the FYCCN application. The committee then considered each site and discussed the pros and cons thereof. The committee reached consensus that the Land Fill/Boar's Nest site allowed for the most flexibility and potential for meeting the greatest variety of uses.

Sherry led an overview of the PPAC's work event plan for that evening at the Spring Hammock Preserve. Two groups would address invasive plant removal and trimming of vegetation on the boardwalk to Lake Jesup.
