Mr. Brandenburg asked if there are any corrections, additions or deletions to the **November minutes**. Tom Boyko made a **motion to approve** the November minutes as submitted, Trish Walden seconded the motion. The motion **passed** unanimously.

Bryan Nipe introduced Herb Hiller. Mr. Hiller explained how he came to be involved in the **River to Sea Loop Trail**. The trail encompasses five counties; St. Johns, Putnam, Flagler, Volusia and Brevard. Much discussion followed. Mr. Brandenburg suggested Seminole could connect with a loop around Lake Monroe. Bob Goff made a **motion** that the Parks & Preservation Advisory Committee develop a letter of support for planning a connecting trail to the River to the Sea Loop Trail. Tom Boyko seconded the motion. The motion **passed** unanimously.

#### **County Commission Summary Report**

- Mr. Boyko reported that the December 13<sup>th</sup> BCC meeting had a couple of items relating to Parks and Greenways:
  - A resolution to implement a budget amendment to a \$400,000 grant to appropriate \$200,000 from DEP Land & Water Conservation grant funding and return \$200,000 to Natural Lands/Trails Fund reserves was approved.

- An agreement with Florida Half Century Amateur Softball Association in the amount of \$10,077 for the 2012 Florida Half Century Senior State Softball Tournaments was approved.
- A Memorandum of Understanding with Florida Fish and Wildlife regarding a Florida Youth Conservation Project for a youth center at the Boar's Head property was approved.
- Bryan Nipe reported that the BCC approved negotiation for the design of three Natural Lands projects by Miller Legg; Black Bear W.A., Geneva W.A. and Lake Harney W.A.

### **Sub-Committee Reports**

#### Natural Lands Subcommittee

- Mr. Brandenburg reported that the Subcommittee reviewed and ranked the Kuhnhausen property. The ranking came in low and they will not be recommending it.
- They also determined that no change is necessary to the ranking criteria.

 Mr. Nipe reported that the Subcommittee did not meet in December and that he will be emailing updates to the entire Committee.

#### Parks & Recreation Subcommittee

 Mr. Goff reported that they met with the City of Casselberry. Casselberry has been able to accomplish a lot with a very small staff. Discussion followed.

#### 501c3 Foundation Subcommittee

Ms. Whittier reported that she has provided County Attorney Bryant Applegate with the Foundation documents to review and make recommendations. She further reported that she has a couple of potential candidates for the PPAC to possibly interview. Bob Steenson reported that he was given names of a couple attorneys to talk to. Commissioner Carey requested that the BCC be kept informed so they can make recommendations for directors.
