The committee discussed the Paddle Florida initiative and Mike Martin will be participating in one of the organized trips on the Wekiva River to Blue Springs State Park. Barbara Whittier asked that Mr. Martin provide a presentation to the Parks and Preservation Advisory Committee in May.

The subcommittee agreed not to commit to a Trails Summit meeting in the near future.

Master Plan

Mr. Goff recommended that the next step in the trails planning process was to connect the city trails to one of the County's main paved trails (Seminole Wekiva Trail, Cross Seminole Trail, Kewannee Trail) to align with providing alternative modes of transportation for the SunRail project, connecting all of the cities and towns via paved trails and finally, to prepare a plan for a one penny transportation tax in the future.

The one year goal for the subcommittee is: To develop a plan that connects city trail systems to the already existing paved County trails system.

State Road 46 Feasibility Study: Subcommittee recommends including a pedestrian trail system that will connect with River-to-Sea Loop. Motion made by Barbara Whittier and seconded by Mike Martin. Motion passed.

Mr. Goff requested that the Engineering Department be invited to give the Committee it's thoughts about the tentative connections between the cities and County trail systems.
